Firestopping for Cable Trays

When cable trays pass through walls, firestopping is essential to prevent fire and smoke spread. Multi-entry seals allow multiple cables to pass through a single wall opening, reducing the number of penetrations and simplifying installation . Right-angle seals can help maintain proper bend radius in tight spaces.

Sealants and Caulks

For smaller gaps or non-fire-rated walls, silicone or latex caulks are effective . For fire-rated walls, use intumescent fire caulk or putty, which expands under heat to maintain fire resistance . Steps include:
