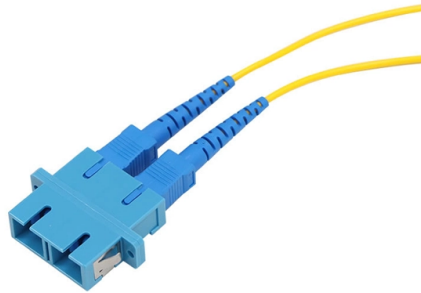

By default, these queries go to your Internet Service Provider's DNS servers — which offer no content filtering, limited privacy, and are often slower than third-party.
