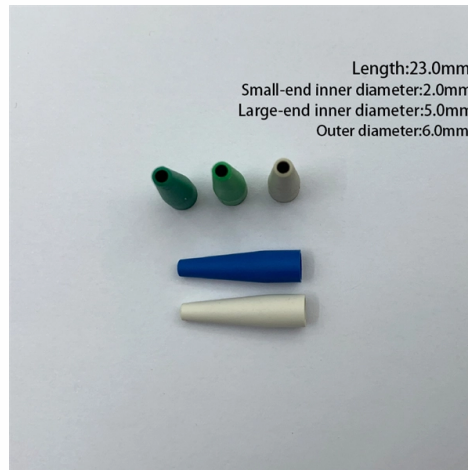


How to sort the color sequence of 144 optical fiber cable

How to Identify Fibers in High-Count Cables (>12 Fibers) For cables with more than 12 strands (e., 48, 96, or 144 fibers), the industry uses a "Tube and Fiber" system. The 12-color sequence is applied twice: first to the outer Buffer Tube, and then to the individual Fiber inside.
