

How to stack access layer switches



Overview

Cisco stackable switches allow multiple physical switches to operate as one logical unit through Cisco StackWise. This method is applicable on access layer switches. These are Core, Distributed layer, and. This article is designed to help network administrators effectively configure, maintain, and troubleshoot switch stacks. Switch stacking is a feature of certain Cisco access layer switches which allows for the creation of a single logical device from many individual devices via a backside stack port connected by several stack cables.
