When storing cable drums for long periods, please take the following guidelines into consideration: ✓ Select a site for storage that is level and dry, preferably indoors with a concrete surface, with no risk of falling objects, chemical spills (oil, grease, etc.) open flames. In no circumstances shall any indoor cable boxes or reels be stored outside or in a harsh environment. Watertight containers located outside may suffer from condensation and therefore cannot be assumed to. Following the right storage practices is essential to keep your fiber optic cables in top condition and maintain their efficiency. Here are some straightforward tips to help you properly handle and store your cables. This may cause wraps of cable to cascade and tangle, causing possible future cable damage when unwinding.
