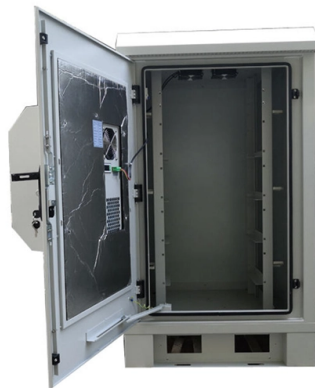


How to switch from fiber optic to router mode

- Configure Router: Access the router's admin panel via a web browser, enter any ISP credentials if required, and set up your Wi-Fi network. Change default usernames and passwords for security .
