

How to tightly wind the strands in a power fiber optic cable

Important Points in Manual Roll: Roll Diameter The minimum roll diameter is $10\times$ the cable diameter (eg: 5mm cable $\rightarrow$ roll diameter $\geq 50\text{mm}$). Avoid rolling too tightly to prevent damage to the optical fibers inside. **Roll Technique** Use a "Figure-8" pattern or a circle with loose turns. The operation and skills of fiber optic fusion splicing technology can be mainly divided into five steps: fiber stripping, fiber cutting, fiber melting, fiber sleeve, and fiber winding.
