- Wall-mounted panels are used for intermediate cross-connections or fiber branches in buildings, supporting 6-48 fibers ().
- Outdoor panels are weatherproof, often rated NEMA 4 or higher, and protect against rain, dust, and wind ().
- DIN-mounted panels are used in industrial settings and attach to standard DIN rails for quick installation and removal ().
