Types of Fiber Optic Cables

- Single-Mode Fiber (SMF)
 - Features a narrow core (typically 9 μm) that allows light to travel straight, minimizing signal loss.
 - Ideal for long-distance transmission and high-speed networks.
 - Commonly used in telecommunications and backbone networks.
- Multimode Fiber (MMF)
 - Has a larger core (50/125 μm or 62.5/125 μm) that supports multiple light paths.
 - Suitable for shorter distances, such as within data centers or server rooms.
 - OM4 multimode fiber offers high-speed performance over short distances with low attenuation.
