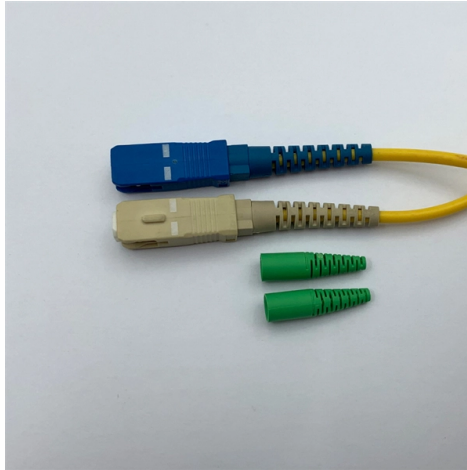


Indoor surface-mounted electrical box installation height



Overview

Particularly, the electrical rule book states that a panel must be installed no less than four feet off the floor. The National Electrical Code provision 110.5 feet (≈ 2 meter) high in front of the panel. The panelboard's door (hinged cover) shall be able to be opened to a full 90° . For a typical residential installation, the standard electrical outlet height is 12 to 16 inches from the finished floor to the bottom of the device box. This standard height ensures that the outlets are easily accessible for vacuum cleaners and floor lamps while remaining low enough to be visually discreet. The proper installation of a distribution box involves placing it at the right height to ensure safety and convenience. This height also safeguards the box from potential. Front clearance: There should be a minimum of 3 feet of clearance at the front of all electrical equipment, including panelboards, switches, breakers, starters, transformers, etc. Side clearance: There should.

If the height of the electrical equipment is less than 6.5 feet, but when mounted, the top of the equipment exceeds 6.5 feet, the minimum workspace height shall be equal to the height of the equipment.
