Ground Installation Guidelines

Grounding Requirements

Proper grounding is critical for safety. Each distribution box must be connected to a central grounding point using appropriately sized ground wires: typically 6 mm² internationally or 10 AWG in the US (). The resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm to ensure safe dissipation of electrical faults. Grounding wires should connect the box to the mounting plate and then to the central ground, with additional connections to spindles or equipment as needed to maintain low resistance ().
