

Installation steps for fiber-to-the-home switch

- **Drop Cables:** Typically preterminated with 1-2 fibers for plug-and-play installation. For single-family homes, these cables connect directly to the ONT. Multi-dwelling units (MDUs) may use patch panels inside the building ().

Fiber Termination and Connection

- **Cleaning and Preparation:** Fiber ends must be cleaned with alcohol wipes to ensure high-quality connections ().
