SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) modules are pluggable interface devices that convert electrical signals from network equipment into optical signals for fiber transmission, or vice versa, enabling high-speed data communication between switches, routers, and media converters. They are hot-swappable, allowing replacement or upgrades without powering down devices, which minimizes downtime in enterprise and data center environments.

High-Speed Variants

- SFP+: Supports 10 Gbps, with improved EMI shielding, lower latency, and better heat dissipation compared to standard SFP.
- SFP28: Designed for 25 Gbps networks, often used in modern data centers and AI/ML server environments.
- SFP56: Uses PAM4 modulation to achieve 50 Gbps, requiring host support for proper decoding.
