- **Inadequate Consolidation:** Insufficient vibration or compaction of the first layer can leave a rough or porous surface that hinders adhesion .
- **Mix Variations:** Differences in water content, aggregate size, or cement type between batches can increase the risk of a cold joint .
- **Environmental Factors:** Temperature, humidity, and wind can accelerate setting in LPC, reducing the time window for continuous pouring .
