Instead of plugging 12 separate LC duplex connectors, you can mate one MPO. To support high-speed, high-capacity transmission, we offer multimode fiber (OM3/OM4) and single-mode fiber (OS2), applicable for 10G, 40G, 100G, and 400GbE transmission. Whether you're supporting parallel optics like 100G SR4 or densifying an optical distribution frame (ODF), MPO is now a cornerstone of network design. It enables precise alignment of multiple fibers (8, 12, 24, or more) within a single interface, significantly increasing cabling density compared to traditional single-fiber connectors. As. To handle higher bandwidth, improve network density, and prepare for future upgrades, more data center designers and network managers are moving to multi-fiber push-on connections or MPOs in their fiber network infrastructure.
