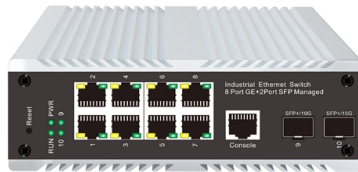


Maintenance of Standard Secondary Distribution Box
