

Markings on optical cables



AI Overview

Markings on optical cables provide essential information about fiber type, performance, compliance, and installation specifications.

Optical cable markings are printed on the cable jacket or outer layer and serve as a guide for technicians to identify the cable's characteristics and ensure proper installation. These markings typically include the cable type (single-mode or multi-mode), fiber mode and core/cladding size (e.g., SM 9/125 or MM 50/125), fiber grade (e.g., G.657A1 for bend resistance), jacket material and fire rating (e.g., OFNR or LSZH), manufacturer name, production date, serial number, and sometimes distance markings to track cable length during installation .

Fiber Type and Mode

- Single-mode (SM) fibers, often marked as 9/125, are designed for long-distance, high-speed transmission using laser light sources .
- Multi-mode (MM) fibers, such as 50/125 or 62.5/125, are suited for short-distance, high-bandwidth applications .
- Fiber grade markings like G.657A1 or G.657A2 indicate bend tolerance, which is critical for installations in tight spaces .

Jacket Material and Fire Ratings

The jacket markings indicate the material and safety compliance, such as OFNR (riser-rated) or LSZH (low-smoke zero-halogen), which informs the installer about fire safety and suitability for indoor or outdoor use .
