Metal cable trays are specified by type, material, finish, load rating, rung spacing, and compliance with standards such as NEMA VE 1 and UL 568.

Types of Metal Cable Trays

Metal cable trays come in several configurations to suit different applications:

- Ladder Tray: Features two side rails with transverse rungs; ideal for heavy power cables and long spans. Rung spacing typically ranges from 6 to 12 inches, with radius fittings often at 9 inches at the center of the tray width .
- Wire Mesh (Basket) Tray: Made of high-strength steel wire; suitable for light instrumentation and control cables, offering flexibility and ventilation .
- Channel Tray: Solid or ventilated bottom; used where aesthetics or electromagnetic interference protection is important .
- Solid Bottom Tray: Provides maximum protection against dust, moisture, and heat buildup; often used for sensitive instrumentation .

Materials and Finishes

The choice of material depends on environmental conditions and mechanical requirements:

- Galvanized Steel: Economical, corrosion-resistant; available in pre-galvanized or hot-dip galvanized finishes .
- Stainless Steel (AISI 316L): High corrosion resistance, especially in chlorinated or marine environments; includes molybdenum for enhanced durability .
