

Method for tying knots in the incoming wires of the distribution box



AI Overview

Use a combination of clove hitch and half hitches with waxed cotton or nylon cord to neatly secure incoming wires in a distribution box.

Materials and Tools

- Cord: Waxed cotton or nylon cord is recommended; nylon is moisture- and fungus-resistant, while cotton should be waxed for protection .
- Scissors or trimming tool: To cut cord ends to approximately 3/8 inch after tying .
- Optional: Needle or lacing tool for precise placement in tight spaces .

- Start the Lacing
- Begin at the thick end of the wire bundle.
- Tie a clove hitch with an extra loop around the bundle to secure the starting point .
- Tie the Bundle
- Continue along the bundle at regular intervals using half hitches or lock stitches.
- Space the knots evenly to maintain a neat and secure bundle.
- At points where wires branch off, tie additional half hitches to secure the branch .
- Terminate the Lacing
- Finish with a clove hitch with an extra loop to secure the free end of the cord.
