2. Mechanical Splicing Mechanical splicing uses connectors and index-matching gel to align fibers without heat. While faster and requiring less expensive equipment, it typically introduces higher loss (0.2–0.5 dB) and may be less reliable in harsh environments. Mechanical splices are suitable for temporary repairs or situations where fusion splicing is impractical .
