Answer: The issue could be related to the Fiber mode being single mode, cable contractor's tests, or SFP. Physical layer faults refer to the hardware faults of the switch and the physical lines connecting to the switch. The physical cable is faulty. The faults of the physical line connecting to the switch generally include: The network cable or optical fiber is damaged, the. I am trying to connect new moxa switch to an existing moxa switch via fiber.
