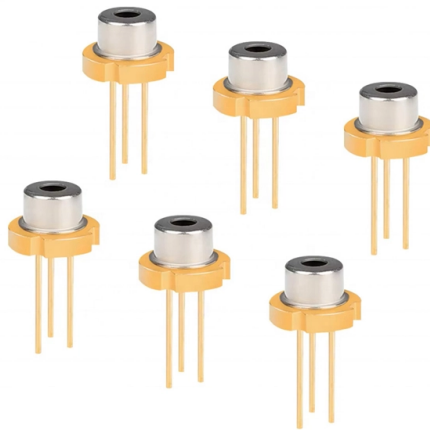

Managed switches often provide LACP (Link Aggregation Control Protocol) to automate this process. 3. Switch Topologies: When connecting multiple switches, the network topology matters:

- Cascading: Connect switches in series to expand port availability. Each switch can be independently managed, but linear cascades have limited redundancy .
- Stacking: Multiple compatible switches are combined into a single logical unit, increasing port density and bandwidth while simplifying management .
- Clustering: Switches operate together for redundancy and load balancing, often used in enterprise networks .
