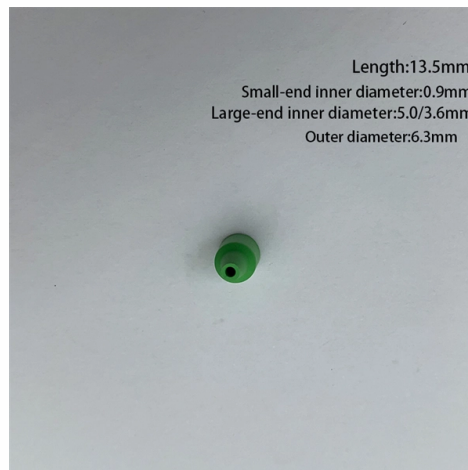

There are two primary methods employed for grounding server racks: hardwiring and the implementation of comprehensive bonding networks. Hardwiring (Direct Ground Connection) Hardwiring involves establishing a direct connection between the server rack and the facility's grounding electrode. Equipment grounding involves connecting the non-current-carrying metal parts of electrical equipment, such as the server rack, to the ground.
