Distribution circuit: an electric circuit supplying one or more distribution boards [this term is defined in the IEC 60050-826-2022]. Distribution boards, often referred to as electrical panels or breaker boxes, serve as the nerve center of any electrical system. In some regulatory documents, instead of the correct term “distribution circuit,” the terms “distribution network” or “electrical distribution network” are still. A distribution board (also known as panelboard, circuit breaker panel, breaker panel, circuit breaker, electric panel, fuse box or DB box) is a component of an electricity supply system that divides an electrical power feed into subsidiary circuits while providing a protective fuse or circuit. A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices.
