AI Overview

Optical modules are hot-pluggable transceivers that convert electrical signals to optical signals and vice versa, enabling high-speed data communication over fiber networks.

Key Components

Transmitter Optical Sub-Assembly (TOSA): Converts electrical signals into optical signals using a light source such as a laser diode (LD) or LED. Laser diodes are preferred for high-speed, long-distance transmission due to higher output power, lower energy consumption, and better coupling efficiency, while LEDs are suitable for short-distance, low-rate applications. TOSA also includes an optical interface, monitoring photodiode, housing, and driver circuitry, often with automatic optical power control (APC) to maintain consistent output power.

Receiver Optical Sub-Assembly (ROSA): Converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals. It contains a photodetector (PIN or avalanche photodiode), a trans-impedance amplifier (TIA), and a post-amplifier. Avalanche photodiodes (APDs) provide higher sensitivity, improving receiver performance by 6–10 dB compared to PIN photodiodes.

Digital Diagnostic Monitoring (DDM): Enables real-time monitoring of module parameters such as operating voltage, temperature, transmitted and received optical power, and laser bias current, ensuring reliable operation and interoperability across vendors.
