They are lightweight, self-supporting, and suitable for aerial deployment, reducing installation costs and enabling pole sharing with existing infrastructure . The cable jacket is typically made of polyethylene (PE) with carbon black for UV protection, ensuring durability in outdoor environments . 2. Armored Outdoor Fiber Optic Cables (e.g., GYTA53) These cables feature corrugated steel or aluminum tape armor for mechanical protection, rodent resistance, and suitability for harsh environments. They can be direct-buried, aerial, or installed in ducts, and support both single-mode and multi-mode fibers. Fiber counts can be customized up to 432 cores, and the cables are designed for long-distance and local area network communication . Armored cables are ideal for areas where mechanical impact or environmental stress is expected. 3. Drop Cables Drop cables run from the distribution point to the subscriber and are often mounted on poles or buildings. Some are self-supporting, requiring no messenger wire, while others may be lashed to existing cables. They are typically smaller in diameter and optimized for last-mile connectivity .
