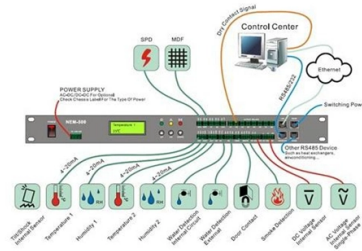


Precautions for fiber optic cable installation in pipelines
