- **Single-Mode Fiber (SMF):** Designed for long-distance transmission with a small core diameter, allowing a single light mode to propagate. It is ideal for high-bandwidth, long-range applications .
- **Multimode Fiber (MMF):** Has a larger core that supports multiple light modes, suitable for shorter distances and high-speed data within buildings or campuses .
- **Simplex vs. Duplex:** Simplex cables carry data in one direction, while duplex cables support bidirectional communication .
