Three key specifications — ANSI/EIA RS-310-D, IEC 60297-2, and DIN 41494 — have defined the foundation of 19-inch rack design used across industries such as telecom, IT infrastructure, and industrial control. Published by the Electronic Industries Association (EIA), RS-310-D. A cabinet or rack must belong to one of the following types: Standard 19-in. four-post EIA cabinet or rack, with mounting posts that conform to English universal hole spacing per section 1 of ANSI/EIA-310-D-1992. Standardization in rackmount systems is essential for ensuring equipment compatibility, optimal space utilization, and global product interoperability. Upon completion of the installation, a third party field verification firm will independently verify.
