

Requirements for cable tray usage in computer room



AI Overview

Cable tray installations in computer rooms must comply with NEC Article 392, IEC 61537, and industry best practices, covering cable types, grounding, fill capacity, separation, support, and fire safety.

Cable Types and Tray Rating

Only tray-rated cables such as Type TC (Tray Cable) or Metal-Clad (MC) are permitted in cable trays to ensure safety and durability under heat, moisture, and mechanical stress conditions . Cables not rated for open-air tray environments should not be installed. The tray system itself must be listed for its location and intended purpose, and capable of supporting the weight of all horizontal and backbone cabling .

Grounding and Bonding

Metallic cable trays must be electrically continuous and properly bonded at all splice points, connected to the building's grounding system . Bonding jumpers should be used where mechanical connections do not provide reliable continuity. Proper grounding prevents shock hazards, equipment failure, and ensures compliance with inspections. The tray system should allow for continuous grounding throughout its length .
