

Requirements for electrical distribution boxes for construction suspended platforms



AI Overview

Electrical distribution boxes for suspended platforms must comply with OSHA wiring requirements and ANSI/ASSP A10.28 safety standards, ensuring proper grounding, overload protection, and secure enclosure for high-altitude construction work.

Regulatory Requirements

OSHA 1926.405 specifies that all conductors entering boxes, cabinets, or fittings must be protected from abrasion, and openings must be effectively closed. Pull and junction boxes must have covers, and metal covers must be grounded. Flexible cords used for temporary wiring should meet ANSI/NFPA 70 standards, and temporary wiring must be removed after construction completion. For systems over 600 volts, fencing or barriers are required to prevent unauthorized access. ANSI/ASSP A10.28-2018 provides safety requirements for work platforms suspended from cranes or derricks. While the standard primarily addresses platform safety, it also covers electrical components, requiring that control and distribution boxes be designed to prevent electrical hazards, ensure proper insulation, and allow safe operation at heights.
