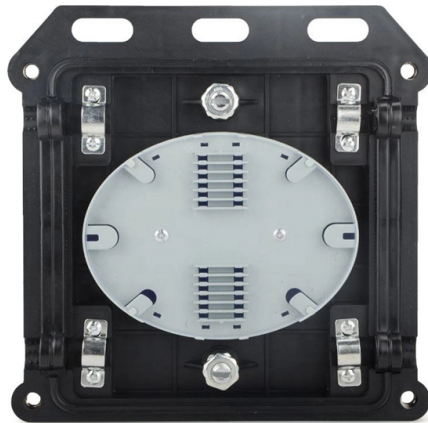
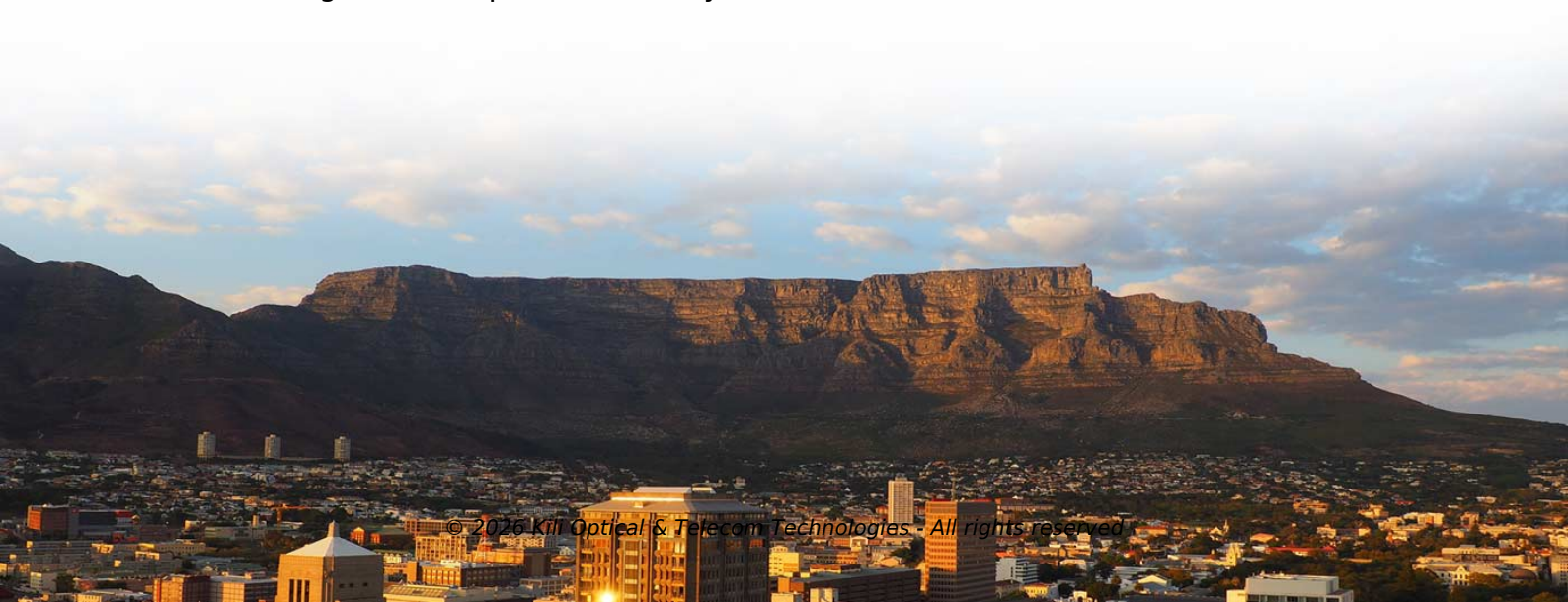


Requirements for fiber optic cable routing at the home entrance box
