Overview

The key feature of ribbon fiber cables is the flat configuration of the fibers using matrix-style ribbons with either 4, 6, 8, or 12 fibers per ribbon (depending on density). It gives mass fusion splicing and increases the density in a limited space. Ribbon cables offer higher fiber counts and greater fiber density than any other cable construction designed for the outside plant (OSP), four times the highest-fiber-count loose tube cable. Ribbon cables also enable mass-fusion splicing, whereby each 12-fiber ribbon can be spliced in a single. Stranded loose-tube cable has been the dominant fiber optic cable design deployed in campus backbones for more than 25 years. Hence, it has become essential for applications requiring maximum data throughput within tight. The technology of ribbon fiber optic cables is well-established in the telecommunications industry and is favored for its high fiber density and compact size.
