Color Coding for Single-Mode Single-Fiber Modules

Single-fiber (BiDi) optical modules transmit and receive signals over a single fiber using different wavelengths for each direction. The pull-tab color provides a quick visual reference for wavelength and distance:

- Blue: 1310nm – typically medium-distance transmission (~10–20 km)
- Purple: 1490nm – medium-distance transmission (~20–40 km)
- Yellow: 1550nm – long-distance transmission (40 km and above)
- Green: 1550nm – ultra-long-distance transmission (80 km and above) These colors help technicians quickly identify the module type without removing it from the port, streamlining installation and maintenance in high-density networks ().

BiDi (Bidirectional) Single-Fiber Modules

BiDi modules use two wavelengths on a single fiber, one for transmitting and one for receiving. Each wavelength pair has a specific pull-tab color combination. For example:

- A BiDi module transmitting at 1310nm and receiving at 1490nm may have a blue pull tab, while the reverse direction module may use purple.
