Wire sizes that are typically found in residential construction branch circuits include 14, 12, 10, 8 and 6-gauge wires, among others. The number designating the size of the wire decreases as the current carrying ability of the wire (measured as ampacity) and diameter of the wire. Most home inspection standards require inspectors to inspect branch circuit conductors (wires) and overcurrent devices (fuses and breakers) and to determine that they are compatible (wires are sized correctly for their respective fuses/breakers). In other words, the circuit conductors runs between the final circuit breaker to the final load circuit such as outlet (s) is known as a branch.
