

Spacing between distribution boxes

Distribution boxes should have a minimum front clearance of 3 feet, side clearance of 30 inches, and sufficient height clearance to allow safe access and maintenance.

Front Clearance

Electrical codes, including the NEC, require a minimum of 3 feet (914 mm) of clear space in front of distribution boxes to allow safe operation, inspection, and maintenance. The panel doors must be able to open at least 90 degrees without obstruction .

Side Clearance

A minimum side clearance of 30 inches is recommended, or at least the width of the equipment itself, to ensure safe access to wiring and components . This spacing prevents interference from walls, pipes, or other equipment.

Height Clearance

The working space should extend from the floor to a height of 6 feet (1.8 meters) above the equipment or to the structural ceiling, whichever is lower . This ensures that maintenance personnel can safely reach all components.

Dedicated Space

In addition to clearances, a dedicated equipment space equal to the width and depth of the distribution box is required. This space should remain free of storage or other obstructions to maintain safety and code compliance .
