- **Bend Radius and Twist Control:** Avoid sharp bends or twists that can damage conductors or degrade signal quality .
- **Slack Management:** Allocate sufficient slack for future moves, adds, or changes without creating clutter .
- **Labeling and Documentation:** Clearly label cables and document their paths to simplify maintenance and troubleshooting .
- **Airflow Optimization:** Route cables to avoid obstructing airflow in racks or cabinets, reducing equipment overheating and cooling costs .

Types of Cable Management Systems

Cable management solutions are generally categorized by orientation and design:

- **Horizontal Cable Managers:** Installed across the width of racks or cabinets to organize patch cables and maintain proper bend radii .
