

# Standard requirements for the thickness of distribution box enclosures

### Regional Standards

In India, IS 14772:2000 specifies general requirements for enclosures of electrical accessories. It aligns with international practices and covers construction, mechanical strength, and protection against heat, rusting, and tracking. While IS 14772 does not prescribe a single thickness, it references material and mechanical performance criteria similar to IEC standards.

### Material Considerations

- Steel enclosures: 1.5–2.5 mm, powder-coated for corrosion resistance, with minimum coating thickness and salt spray resistance per ISO 9227.
