Instead, industry best practice, or journeyman electrician standards, dictates a height of 12-16 inches from the finished floor to the bottom of the box, or 16-18 inches to the centerline.

Residential Electrical Code Requirements

Standard wall switch height is 4 feet from the top of the flooring to the bottom of the box. Metal boxes are required when using metal raceways to run wiring, both as an anchor for the conduit
