A switch is a Layer 2 (and sometimes Layer 3) network device that connects multiple devices within a local area network (LAN), forwarding data based on MAC addresses. Switches manage high device density, reduce network congestion, and can include advanced features like Power over Ethernet (PoE), stacking, and integrated security for enterprise or industrial environments . Fiber-capable switches allow connections over long distances using optical cables, supporting high-speed uplinks and backbone links .

Routers

A router operates at Layer 3, directing data packets between different IP networks. Routers are essential for connecting LANs to external networks, such as the internet, and for managing traffic efficiently across multiple subnets. They perform routing, NAT, firewall functions, and sometimes VPN services, ensuring data reaches the correct destination .
