Materials and Construction

- **Coating:** Pre-galvanized steel is coated with zinc to prevent corrosion, while hot-dip galvanizing provides a thicker protective layer for outdoor or harsh environments.
- **Design:** The tray consists of longitudinal side rails connected by transverse rungs. In T-type fittings, one tray intersects perpendicularly with another, requiring precise cutting and welding or bolting to maintain structural integrity.
- **Ventilation:** Ladder-style T-trays often include perforated rungs or slots to allow airflow, reducing heat buildup and preventing cable damage.
