This approach leverages the natural rise of warm air and can increase cooling efficiency by 30% or more, reduce hot spots, and allow higher setpoint temperatures, which lowers energy consumption. Typical implementations include containment curtains, steel or cementitious panels, and blanking panels to seal gaps and optimize airflow.

Remote Monitoring Types

Remote monitoring in data centers focuses on temperature, humidity, and airflow sensors distributed throughout the facility. These sensors feed data to centralized monitoring software, enabling:

- Real-time alerts for temperature or humidity deviations
- Automated adjustments to cooling systems (CRAC/PAHU units)
- Energy efficiency tracking and PUE optimization
