Temporary distribution boxes must be properly grounded using approved grounding electrodes, such as ground rods, to ensure safety and compliance with the NEC.

Purpose of Grounding

Grounding a temporary distribution box connects the system to earth potential, stabilizing voltage during normal operation and protecting against lightning, line surges, or accidental contact with higher voltage sources. The equipment grounding conductor (EGC) bonds all non-current-carrying metal parts to the grounded conductor and the grounding electrode, providing a low-impedance path for fault current to facilitate operation of overcurrent protective devices.

Grounding Electrode Options

According to the NEC, acceptable grounding electrodes include:

- Ground rods (copper or copper-bonded steel)
- Metal underground water pipes
- Concrete-encased electrodes (rebar or copper conductor)
- Ground plates or ground rings For temporary setups, ground rods are most commonly used due to portability and ease of installation. High-quality copper-bonded steel rods are recommended to prevent corrosion and maintain long-term conductivity.
