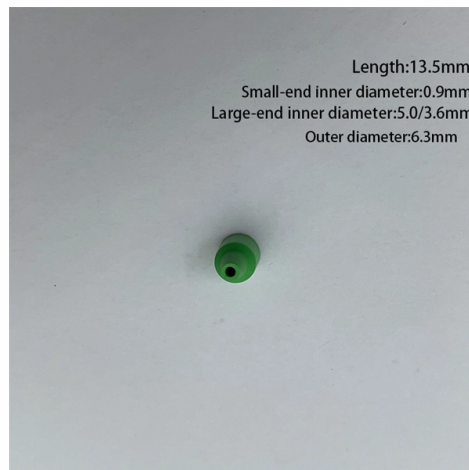


Terminal access to aggregation switch

Methods of Terminal Access

- Console Access
- Connect a terminal or PC directly to the switch's console port using a serial cable.
- This method is typically used for initial configuration or recovery when network access is unavailable.
- SSH (Secure Shell)
- Provides secure remote access over the network.
- Requires the switch to have an IP address configured and SSH enabled.
- Recommended for routine management due to encryption and security.
- Telnet (less secure)
- Allows remote access but transmits credentials in plaintext.
- Generally discouraged in modern networks in favor of SSH.
