Cable tray supports should be strategically positioned so that connectors between horizontal straight sections of the tray fall between the support point and the quarter-point of the span. Unlike a simple wire trough, which is typically a covered channel for shorter runs, cable trays provide a comprehensive support system for complex wiring paths over long. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend ra-dius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray.
