- SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable): Hot-pluggable modules that support fiber or copper connections, typically for 1G or 10G speeds. They convert electrical signals from the switch into optical signals for the fiber cable and vice versa .
- QSFP (Quad SFP): High-speed modules for 40G or higher, capable of handling multiple data streams simultaneously, often used for core switches or high-performance servers . The module type must match the fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) and the switch port type (SFP, SFP+, or combo port) to ensure proper operation .
