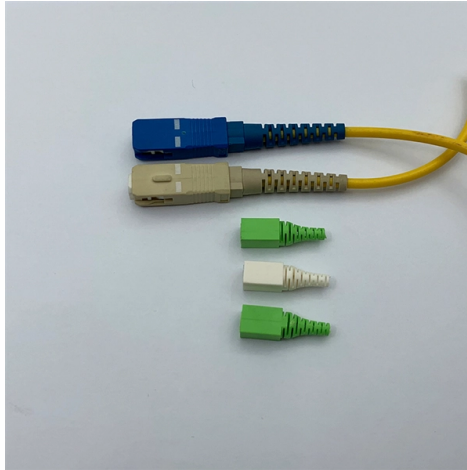


The function of a fusion splice cap junction box
