Cable Handling and Precautions

- Bend Radius and Tension: Fiber optic cables are sensitive to sharp bends and excessive pulling forces. Always respect the minimum bend radius and maximum rated cable load (MRCL) to prevent microbending or signal loss, which may not appear until years after installation .
