

Under what circumstances can the pigtail cable not be pulled out

- When more conductors are present than a device terminal can safely hold, pigtails are required to avoid overloading a single screw terminal .
- On MWBCs, the neutral must be pigtailed to prevent interruption of the shared neutral if a device is removed .
