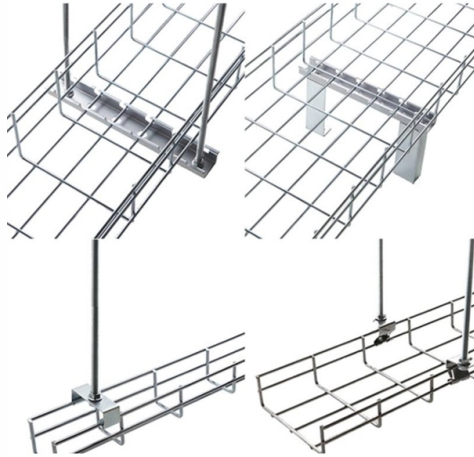

Clearances: Maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance above trays for installation and maintenance access (2026 NEC update). Prohibited Areas: Cable trays cannot be.
